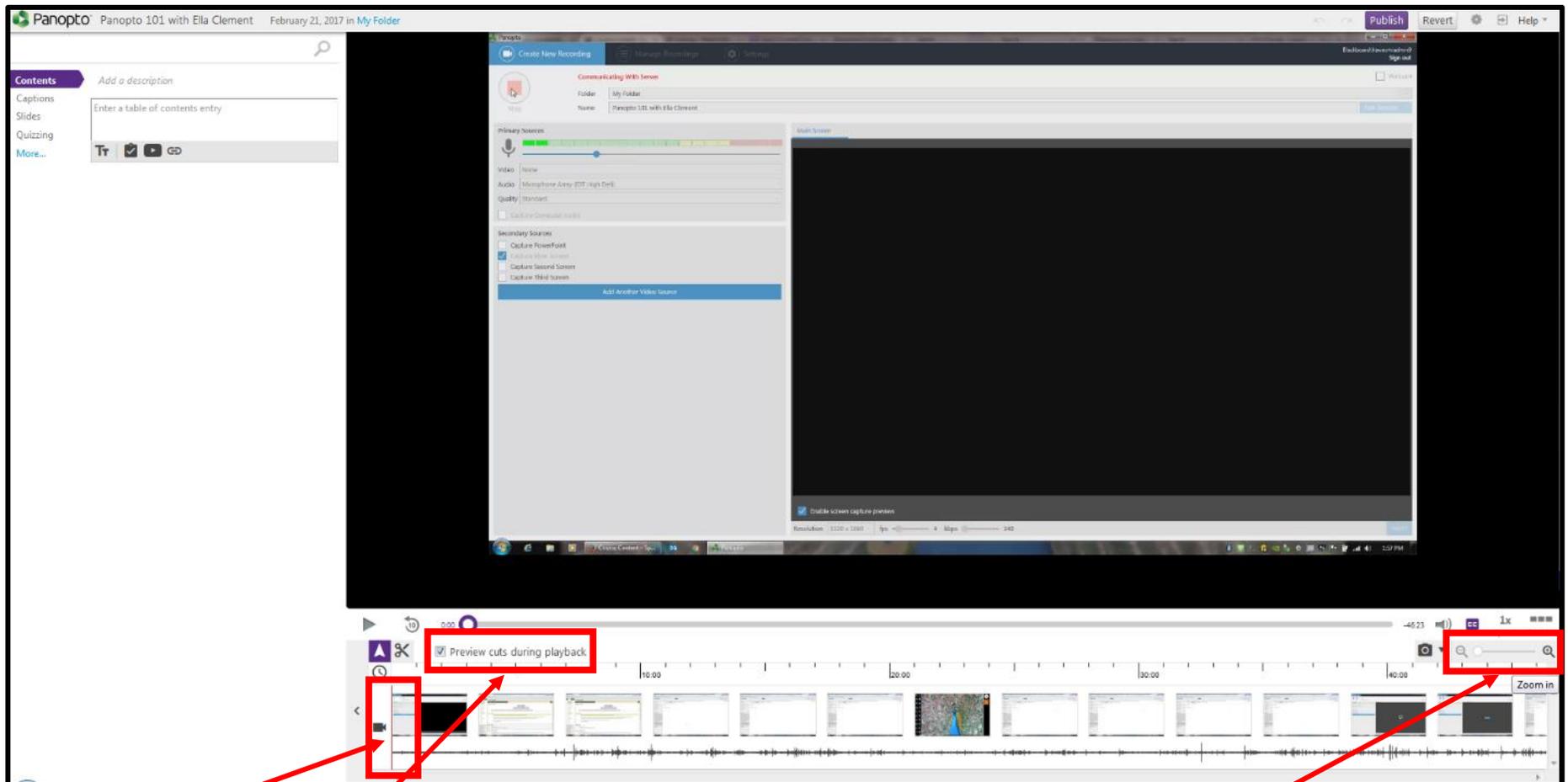


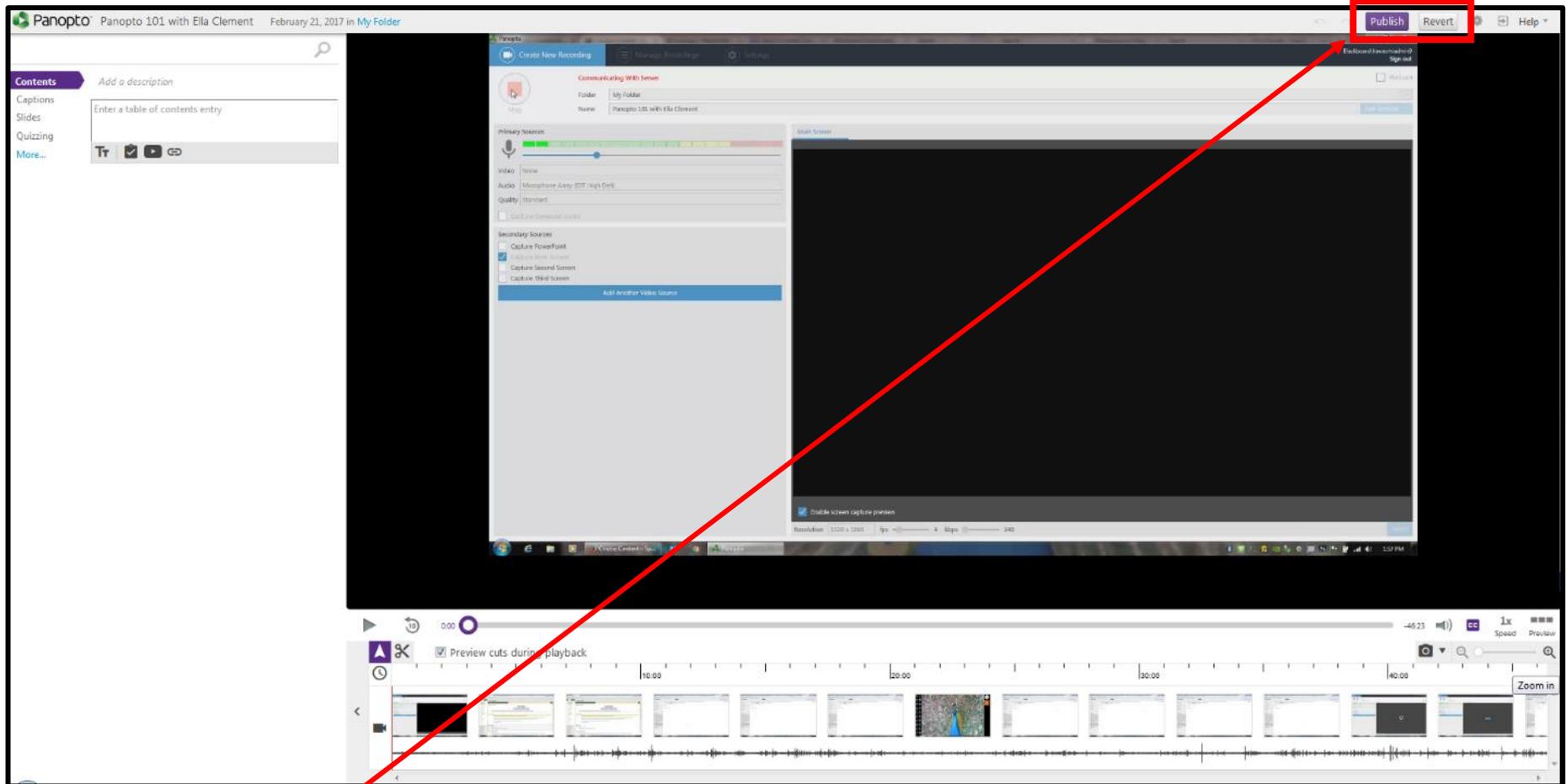
Editing in Panopto

When you enter the edit mode, there are several things to look at:



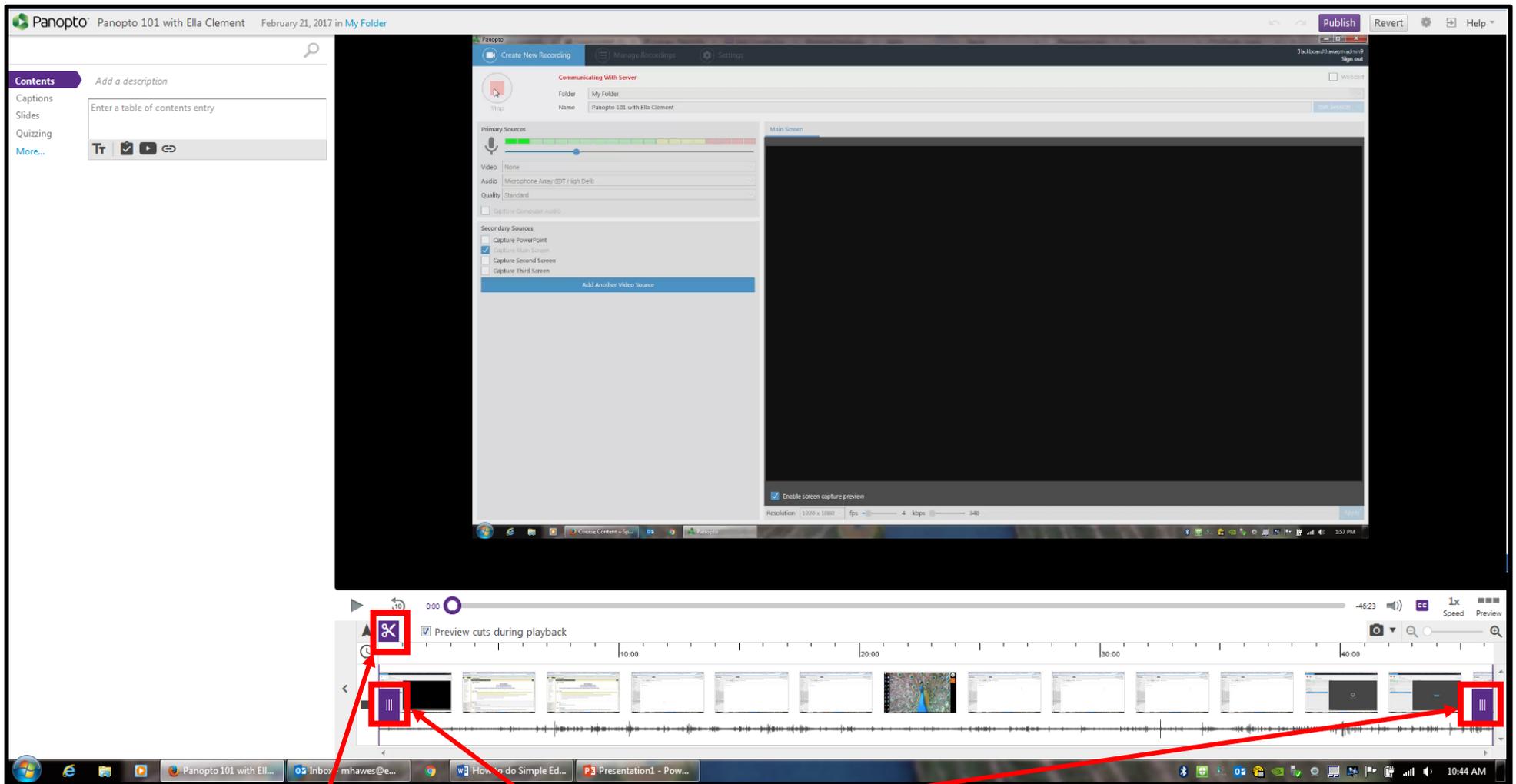
- This **red line** indicates where you are within the video and is important when want to cut in the middle of the video.
- Make sure this **box** is checked so your playback incorporates any editing you've done.
- This **toggle** allows you to zoom your timeline in and makes it easier to edit more precisely.

Here are a few more items to look at:



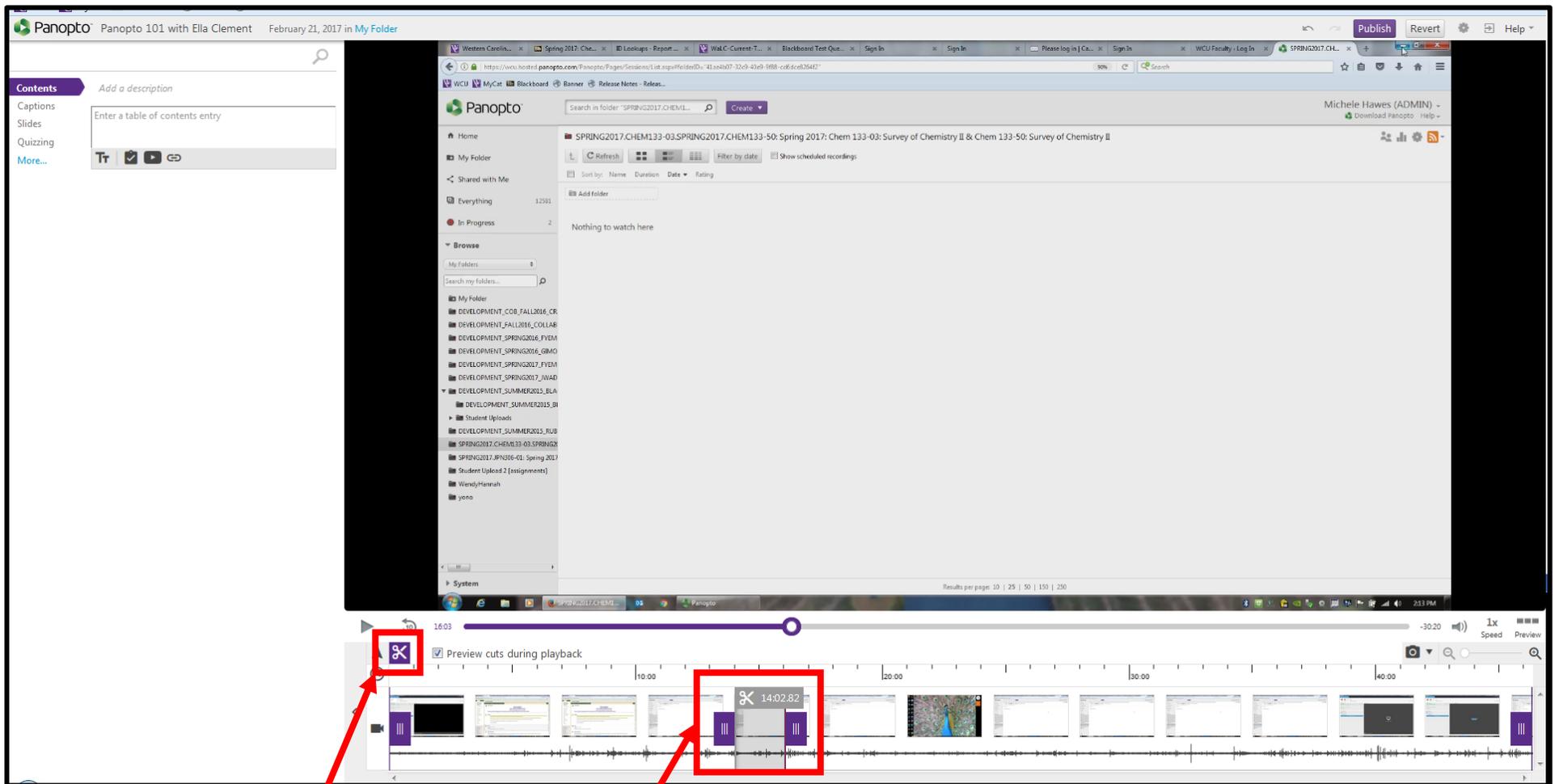
- The **PUBLISH** button finalizes your edits and re-processes the video. Once you hit this button – there's no going back!
- The **REVERT** button allows you to undo any editing and start over.

To snip either the beginning or the end of a video you will need to:



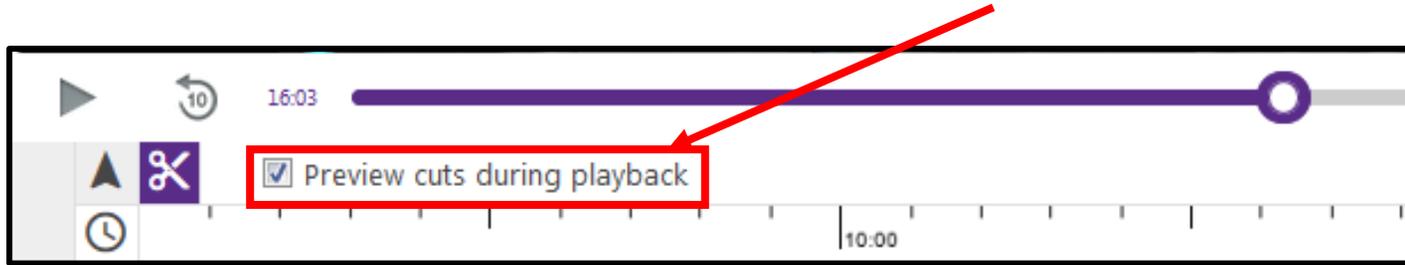
- Click on the **Scissor** tool.
 - Once you do, you will see **two purple tabs** appear at the beginning and the end of the video.
 - When you **click and drag** these tabs, you will see that the video is being highlighted. This is the part of the video that will be cut.

To cut in the middle of the video you will need to:

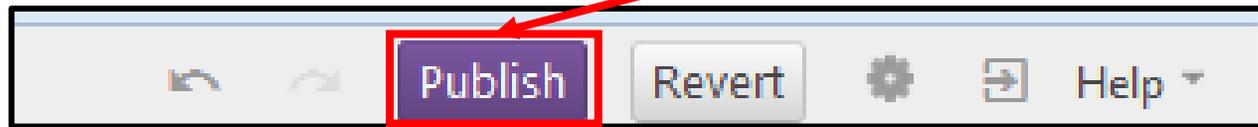


- Have the scissors on and then you will click and hold your left mouse button at the beginning of where you want to cut the video and, while continuing to hold your left mouse button, carefully slide to the right until you reach the end of where you want to cut the video.
 - Now you will see that the area between the purple tabs is highlighted. This is the section that will be cut.

- To play your video with the section cuts, make sure the **“Preview cuts during playback” box is checked.**



When you feel you have made all the edits and your video is the way you want it, **click the PUBLISH button** at the top. Remember – once you click Publish, you **can no longer Revert** the changes you’ve made.



Once the video finishes processing, it will be ready for viewing.
